

RISK MANAGEMENT POLICY

Policy

NSW Lacrosse Inc aims to use best practice in risk management to support and enhance our activities in all areas of our organisation. We will ensure risk management is an integral part of all our decision making processes.

We will adopt best practices as outlined by the NSW Department of Sport & Recreation in assisting our organisation to manage our risk to minimise reasonably foreseeable disruption to our operations, harm to people and damage to the environment and property. We will identify and take advantage of opportunities as well as minimising adverse effects.

We will train our people to implement risk management effectively. We will strive to continually improve our risk management practices.

Responsibilities

The Risk Champion appointed by the board or committee is accountable to the board for the implementation of the risk management process and ultimately responsible for the management of risks in the organisation.

The role of Risk Champion will generally be the responsibility of the President or Vice President of NSW Lacrosse Inc.

All key personnel are responsible for managing risks in their areas.

Process

A risk management program has been established, based on the NSW Department of Sport & Recreation Risk Management Resource which follows the Australian Standard AS/NZS 4360:1999 and the National Risk Management Guidelines. It should be used for guidance by everyone involved with the application of risk management. It should be used for guidance by everyone involved with the application of risk management.

Monitoring and Review

The Risk Champion will monitor and review the implementation of the risk management program and report to the board at every meeting, as appropriate.

The Risk Management Committee will facilitate the development of a common risk management approach across areas of our organisation by:

- implementing the risk management program
- sharing information with broad applicability across all areas
- reporting on the progress of implementing the risk management program.
